

How to connect optical fiber cable to optical transceiver

Step 4: Insert the Transceiver Remove the dust cap from the transceiver port and insert the transceiver into the SFP or SFP+ slot of your device. Secure it according to the manufacturer's instructions. Keep the dust cap for future use to protect the transceiver when disconnected.

Step 5: Connect the Fiber Cable Remove the protective cap from the fiber connector. Insert the fiber into the transceiver port, ensuring the TX (transmit) and RX (receive) ports are correctly aligned with the corresponding ports on the peer device. The connector should click or lock into place securely.

Step 6: Cable Management Avoid tight bends or loops in the fiber cable. Use velcro straps or cable managers to secure excess cable and pre...
