Armoured cables (SWA) are commonly used for direct burial due to their inherent protection, while unarmoured cables require installation in a conduit or duct that provides equivalent mechanical protection (BS 7671:2018+A2:2022, Regulation 522.8.10). Suitable conduits include rigid PVC, DB2 rigid conduit, or concrete-encased ducts, which shield cables from impact, compression, and sharp objects in the soil.

Depth Requirements The depth of buried cables depends on the environment and potential disturbances. For low-voltage cables, a minimum burial depth of 450 mm is recommended in footways or areas with light traffic. In areas with heavy traffic or construction activity, deeper burial or additional protection, such as concrete covers, may be necessary. The depth should be determined by engineering judgment, considering soil conditions, potential excavation, and local regulations.

Marking and Identification To prevent accidental damage during future excavation, buried cables should be marked with warning tapes or cable covers above the conduit or duct. Some tapes include a metallic strip detectable by cable locators, providing early warning of underground electrical services. Proper marking ensures safety for maintenance personnel and compliance with safety standards.
