

How to connect the electricity meter to the distribution box

Connect the two hot conductors (typically black and red) to the line terminals of the meter socket. Connect the neutral conductor to the neutral terminal and the ground wire to the grounding bus.

Connect the Meter to the Distribution Box From the meter socket, run the service entrance cable to the distribution box. Feed the wires through the knockout hole and secure them with cable clamps. Connect the hot wires to the main breaker terminals, the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar, and the ground wire to the grounding bus.

Install Circuit Breakers Connect branch circuits to the appropriate breakers according to load requirements. Use double-pole breakers for 240V appliances and single-pole breakers for standard 120V circuits. Ensure proper color coding: black/red for hot, white for neutral, green/bare for ground.
