

How to connect the fiber optic cable for home network

Connecting fiber optic internet to your home involves linking the fiber line to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) and then connecting the ONT to your router for full internet access.

Step 1: Fiber Line Entry Fiber optic service can enter your home either aerially (from a pole) or underground (through a conduit or pipe) depending on your location and ISP setup. A technician typically installs a Network Interface Device (NID) outside your home, where the fiber is coiled and safely terminated.

Step 2: Installing the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) The ONT is a device that converts the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals your devices can use. It is usually installed near your electrical panel or in a convenient indoor location. The ONT must be connected to a power source, and in some setups, it may be combined with a router in a single unit.

Step 3: Connecting the Fiber to the ONT Plug the fiber optic cable into the designated port on the ONT. Fiber cables typically have SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors and are thin, often yellow. Handle the cable carefully to avoid bending or damaging the delicate glass strands.

Step 4: Linking the ONT to Your Router Use a Cat6 or higher Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. This allows your router to distribute internet to all devices via Wi-Fi or wired connections. For larger homes, mesh Wi-Fi systems may be added to ensure full coverage.

Step 5: Powering and Testing Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes). Then, power on your router and check that the indicator lights confirm a successful connection. The technician may test the connection speed and Wi-Fi coverage to ensure optimal performance.

Step 6: Optional Protection and Backup Consider adding a UPS or surge protector to safeguard the ONT and router from power fluctuations. This helps maintain interne...
