

How to connect the live wire in the home electrical distribution box

Avoiding Jumpers: Do not use jumper wires from the top of one breaker to feed others, as this can cause the first wire to carry the sum of all downstream currents, creating a serious overload hazard. Instead, use single-bolt parallel groove connectors or route separate wires from the main switch to each breaker.

Connection to RCD (if used): If an RCD is installed, the live wire should pass through it before reaching the MCBs. This ensures that any leakage current is detected and the circuit is safely disconnected.
