

How to determine core switch parameters

- Quality of Service (QoS)** `show policy-map interface` displays QoS policies applied to interfaces. `show mls qos` provides global QoS statistics.
- Redundancy and Power** `show redundancy` checks the status of redundant supervisors or power supplies. `show environment` displays fan and temperature status to ensure hardware redundancy.
- Routing and ARP Tables** `show ip route` lists routing table entries. `show arp` displays ARP table entries for IP-to-MAC mapping.
- 802.1X and Security** `show dot1x all` or `show dot1x interface` provides authentication status for ports using 802.1X.

Using Command Help Use `?` after a command to see available parameters. For example, `enable ?` shows all options for the `enable` command. This is useful for discovering additional parameters without consulting documentation.

Best Practices Always operate in privileged EXEC mode for full visibility. Regularly check interfaces, VLANs, QoS, and redundancy to ensure optimal core switch performance. Document configurations and monitor logs to detect anomalies early. By combining these commands, you can comprehensively view an...
