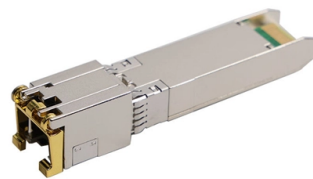

After removal, clean the connector end with a fiber optic cleaning wipe or alcohol pad. Place a dust cap on the connector to prevent contamination ().
- 7. Coil and Store the Cable Properly**
Loosely coil the fiber optic cable to avoid kinking or bending beyond its minimum bend radius. Inspect the cable for any visible damage before reuse ().
