

How to divide the cable tray in the vertical shaft into T-junctions

This method uses couplers, corner strength bars, and adjustable connectors to secure the intersecting trays. It allows flexibility in planning the route and ensures structural integrity.

- Load Capacity:** Ensure the tray and fittings can support the weight of the cables, especially at junctions and bends.
- Cable Segregation:** Maintain separation of power, control, and data cables to comply with EMC and safety standards.
- Bend Radius:** Respect the minimum bend radius of cables to prevent damage. Semi-T fittings often specify a radius (e.g., 160 mm) to maintain cable integrity.
- Support and Anchoring:** Vertical T-junctions should be properly anchored...
