

How to identify a three-way cable tray

- Thermal and structural inspection:** Use infrared imaging or ultrasonic flaw detection to identify hidden defects that may compromise the junction.

- IEC 61537 specifies construction, load, and installation requirements for metallic cable trays, including T-piece junctions .
- DIN EN 61537 and manufacturer technical guides provide definitions and diagrams for three-way fittings, ensuring correct identification and compatibility with the main tray system .
