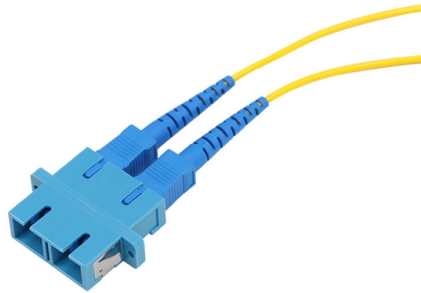


How to insert the drop fiber optic cable into the fiber distribution box
