

How to install clips on cable trays

.Attach Fixing Clips: Secure the tray to the support using the selected clips. Clips can be fastened to steel beams, welded steel structures, or concrete using self-drilling dowels or approved anchors. Ensure the clip spacing does not exceed 3 meters for ladder trays and 2 meters for perforated trays to prevent sagging or strain (Paktechpoint).

.Secure Cables: Once the tray is fixed, cables can be fastened using stainless steel strips, nylon ties, or perforated straps. Horizontal trays typically require fastening every 2-3 meters, while vertical trays need more frequent attachment (Paktechpoint).

.Check Load Capacity: Ensure the tray and clips can support the intended load, typically designed for 100 kg/m for standard installations (Paktechpoint).
