Clean each connector with a fiber optic cleaner before plugging it in, even if it is new, to prevent signal loss caused by dust or contamination. For high-density setups, use MPO connectors for 12, 24, or 48 fibers, ensuring correct polarity (Type A, B, or C) and proper alignment when connecting to adapters or transceivers.

**Testing and Documentation** After installation, test each fiber link for insertion loss and return loss using an MPO tester or OTDR. Record all test results, cable maps, and port assignments for future reference and t...
