

How to install multi-way elbows on cable trays

Use appropriate connectors and fasteners to secure elbows to straight sections, allowing for slight longitudinal movement to accommodate thermal expansion.
- Bonding and Grounding** Install bonding jumpers at each elbow and expansion joint to maintain electrical continuity. Ground cable trays at least every 15 m (50 ft) and at both ends, and ensure conduit drop-outs are bonded to the tray using a compression lug or grounding bushing.
- Material Considerations** Select elbows made from the same material as the tray (e.g., steel, aluminum, stainless steel) to ensure compatibility and corrosion resistance. For outdoor or corrosive environments, consider galvanized or stainless steel elbows to enhance durability.
- Installation Techniques** Trapeze or swing supports are commonly used for ceiling-mounted cable trays.
