

How to install the horizontal bend in the cable tray

Support and Securing the Bend Once a horizontal bend is installed, it is essential to provide adequate support at and near the bend. Supports should be placed close enough to prevent sagging or deformation, typically within 1.2 meters (4 feet) of the bend for ladder or tray systems. Use manufacturer-approved fittings and clamps to secure the bend to the support structure, ensuring that the tray remains level and aligned with the rest of the system.

Maintaining Minimum Bend Radius Cables must not be stressed or bent beyond their minimum bend radius as they exit the bend. This prevents insulation damage and ensures long-term reliability. For most power and instrumentation cables, the bend radius is typically 6 to 12 times the cable diameter, but always refer to the cable manufacturer's specifications.

Inspection and Preparation for Cable Pulling After the bend is installed: Check for sharp edges or burrs on cut or drilled tray sections and treat them with protective coatings if necessary. Ensure all fittings are tightened and that the bend is properly aligned with adjacent tray sections. Verify clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance, avoiding interference with other services. Install sleeves or protective guards at wall crossings or areas where cables may rub against the tray.

Additional Considerations If using ladder or ventilated trays, ensure rung spacing is maintained to support cables evenly through the bend. For multi-tray systems, center-hung or double clamps may be used to support adjacent trays and maintain stability. Document the installation and perform a visual inspection to confirm that the bend and supports meet design and safety standards...
