- 5. Polishing the Fiber Endface**The fiber endface is polished to achieve a smooth, flat, or angled surface depending on the connector type (e.g., SC, ST, FC, LC). Polishing reduces back reflection and insertion loss. Multi-step polishing procedures may involve coarse, medium, and fine polishing films.
- 6. Testing and Quality Control**After assembly, connectors are tested for insertion loss, return loss, and mechanical inte...
