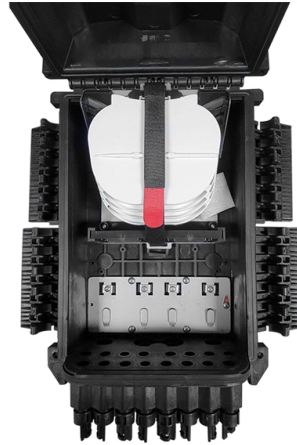

For example, Type TC-ER cables can exit a cable tray unsupported for up to 6 feet if they are protected from physical damage and properly supported at the transition point. This ensures compliance with electrical codes while allowing some flexibility in layout. Best Practices Minimize unnecessary bends and elevation changes to simplify installation and reduce stress on cables. Ensure adequate clearance for maintenance and inspection. Use separators or dividers if different cable types are installed in the same tray to prevent interference. Follow manufacturer guidelines for load rating and support spacing to prevent deformation or overloading.
