- Polishing and Inspection** Polish the ferrule end-face using automatic machines and ultrasonic cleaning. Inspect under a 400x microscope for scratches or contamination to ensure low insertion loss (IL) and high return loss (RL), .
- Testing** Perform IL and RL testing to verify optical performance. Interferometers may be used to ensure connector durability and signal quality .
- Packaging** After testing, patch cords are labeled, coiled, and packaged according to order specifications, ensuring protection during transport .
