

How to replace a router with a broadband fiber optic cable

Check if your ISP requires PPPoE or VLAN settings (common in providers like Deutsche Telekom, which uses PPPoE over VLAN7). Confirm that your router supports the necessary authentication method if your ISP enforces login credentials.

Steps to Replace Your Router

Confirm ONT Setup: Make sure the ISP has installed and activated the ONT.

Disconnect the Old Router: Power down and unplug the ISP-provided router.

Connect Your Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port.

Configure Router Settings: Access the router's admin panel (usually via 192.168.1.1) to enter PPPoE credentials, VLAN ID, or DHCP settings as required.

Power On and Test: Turn on the router and check the internet connection and speed to ensure proper setup.

Optimize Wi-Fi Placement:

Place the router centrally in your home to reduce dead zones and extend coverage.
