Use soft Velcro ties instead of plastic zip ties to secure the cable without crushing it. Routing and Protection Whenever possible, use existing conduits or low-voltage pathways. For open wall cavities or high-traffic areas, protect the fiber with flexible low-voltage conduit to prevent accidental damage and ensure longevity. Avoid metal-sheathed outdoor fiber if electrical isolation is important, as metal can transmit surges. For outdoor runs, bury the cable underground or attach it to utility poles following safety guidelines. Connecting and Testing Once the fiber reaches the ONT, connect it according to your ISP's specifications. The ONT is then linked to your router via Cat6 Ethernet cable or directly through a fiber network adapter if supported. Power on the ONT, configure...
