

How to run fiber optic cables to a switch

- Check Polarity:** Always connect transmit (TX) to receive (RX) and vice versa to ensure proper signal flow.
- Test the Link:** Verify connectivity and signal quality. Clean connectors if necessary to prevent attenuation or signal loss.

Best Practices

- Use LSZH jackets for indoor installations and PE-jacketed OS2 for outdoor runs.
- Avoid tight bends; maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer.
- For outdoor installations, bury fiber in conduit to protect against physical damage and environmental factors.
