

# How to use a laser diode in a CD DVD reader

Connect the ground first, then the positive lead, and use a series resistor if needed to limit current. Many diodes include a reference photodiode to stabilize output power, which can be used to prevent thermal drift.

**Optics and Focusing** For practical use, the diode must be properly aligned with a lens. You can either leave the diode in its original housing and adjust the lens for a focused beam or transfer it to a compatible optical mount. The focal length can be adjusted from a few millimeters to over a meter, depending on the lens setup. Misalignment can prevent proper focusing and may damage the diode.

**Safety Considerations** Laser diodes from CD/DVD drives are often Class IIIb, capable of causing permanent eye damage. Always wear laser-rated safety glasses, never point the beam at people, animals, or reflective surfaces, and ensure the diode is mounted in a metal heat sink to dissipate heat. Even low-power diodes can be dangerous if misused.
