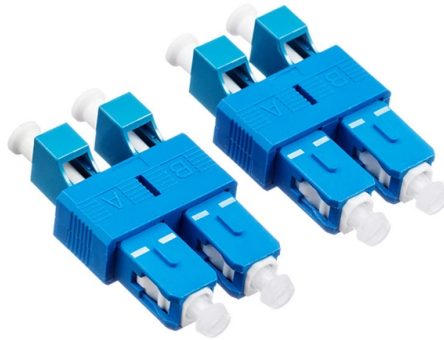


How to use fiber optic cables as routers in Kyrgyzstan

Equipment Needed

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT):** This device converts the fiber optic signal from your ISP into an Ethernet signal that your router can use . ISPs in Kyrgyzstan typically provide the ONT when you subscribe to fiber service.
- Fiber-Compatible Router:** Ensure your router supports fiber input, usually via an SFP port or a WAN port labeled for fiber/ONT connections . Not all routers can handle high-speed fiber connections.
- Fiber Optic Cable:** Typically a thin yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet Cable:** To connect the ONT to your router's WAN port.

Step-by-Step Setup

- Install the ONT:** Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT. Power it on and wait for the status lights to stabilize (usually 2-5 minutes), .
- Connect the ONT to the Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port .
- Configure the Router:** Access the router's interface via a web browser (common IPs: 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1). Enter your ISP-provided details such as IP address, subnet mask, and DNS server. Save settings and reboot the router .
- Verify Connection:** Ensure the router's indicator light...
