

How to wire a junction box with one input and four outputs

Organize Wires: Carefully fold the wires into the junction box, ensuring no sharp bends or pinched insulation. Use cable ties to keep wires neat.

Secure the Box: Mount the junction box according to your installation type (wall, panel, or DIN rail) and replace the cover.

Test the Circuit: Turn the power back on and verify that all outputs are receiving power correctly using a voltage tester.
