

How to wire an old-style construction site electrical distribution box

Twist the wires together securely and cover with electrical tape if desired. **Insert wires** into the box carefully, ensuring no sharp bends or pinching. For old work boxes, feed the wires through the clamps before securing the box in the wall. **Mount the device** (switch, outlet, or fixture) to the box using screws, then attach the cover plate. **Final Checks** After wiring, double-check all connections and ensure the box is firmly mounted. Restore power at the breaker and test the device with a voltage tester or by operating the switch/outlet.
