

How to wire the switches in a distribution box neatly

 - Connect the earth wire from the supply or earth pit to the earth link.
- 5. Connect the Loads**
 - For SP MCBs: Connect the phase terminal of the load to the MCB output, and the neutral and earth to their respective links.
 - For DP MCBs: Connect both phase and neutral terminals of the load to the MCB output, and the earth to the earth link.
- 6. Organize and Secure Wires**
 - Route wiring neatly: main circuit wiring on the left, outgoing circuits on the right.
 - Use plastic ties to bind wires, keeping them straight and evenly spaced.
 - Clearly label all wires for voltage levels and circuit identification.
- 7. Testing and Inspection** After wiring, use a multimeter to verify connections. Check for short circuits...
