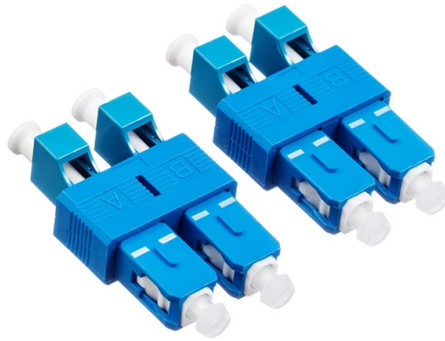


Huawei Switch Fiber Port Cascading



AI Overview

Huawei S Series switches can be cascaded using fiber ports through service port stacking or dedicated stack cables, forming a logical stack for simplified management and redundancy. Overview of Fiber Port Cascading Cascading Huawei switches via fiber ports allows multiple switches to operate as a single logical device, increasing port capacity, bandwidth, and reliability. This is commonly implemented using service port stacking or dedicated stack cables. Fiber ports used for cascading are typically high-speed SFP/SFP+ ports configured as stack ports rather than regular service ports.

Pre-Configuration Checklist

- Verify Switch Model Support:** Only certain S Series switches support stacking. For example, S2700EI, S2720EI, S2750EI, S3700SI/EI, S5700, and S6700 series support stacking, while S1700 series and some S2700 models do not.
- Firmware Consistency:** Ensure all switches run the same VRP (Versatile Routing Platform) version to avoid compatibility issues.
- Select Stack Ports:** Use dedicated stack ports or service ports capable of stacking. Ordinary service ports can be used but may require manual configuration.
- Topology Planning:** Prefer ring topology for redundancy; chain topology is simpler but introduces a single point of failure.
- Assign Member IDs and Priorities:** Configure stack member IDs and priorities before connecting fiber stack cables to ensure proper master and standby selection.

Configuration Steps

- Enter System View:** Log in to each switch via console or SSH and enter system view.
- Configure Logical Stack Ports:** Identify the fiber ports to be used for stacking and add them as stacking ports. For example, ports 1 and 8 can be designated as stack ports, making them unavailable for normal service traffic.
- Connect Fiber Stack Cables:** Use certified fiber cables (e.g., QSFP-40G-Stack) to connect the stack ports between switches. For ring topology, connect the last switch back to the first switch.
- Enable Stacking:** Activate stacking on each switch. Some models support zero-configuration stacking, automatically detecting and forming th...
