

Inspection Standards for Busbars of Distribution Cabinets



Overview

Inspect the busbar surface for oxidation discoloration, burn marks, or obvious deformation. Use oxide inhibitor compound on Cu-Al joints. 3 severity criteria: DT 1-10 °C = Monitor; 11-20 °C = Investigate; > 20 °C = Immediate action. Scan under $\pm 40\%$ rated load for valid results. Measure with calibrated DLRO (Digital Low-Resistance Ohmmeter). De-energise and lock. The purpose of this method is to verify the functionalities of a Metal Enclosed Busbar.
