Step 3: Mounting the Box Mark drill holes using a spirit level to ensure the box is straight. Drill the holes and insert dowels or anchors. Secure the box to the wall or structure with screws, ensuring it is firmly attached and stable ().

Step 4: Cable Preparation Carefully strip the outer sheath of the fiber optic cable without damaging the delicate fibers inside. Insert the cable through the designated openings or cable glands in the junction box. Ensure sufficient fiber length for splicing and connection to terminal blocks ().

Step 5: Fiber Splicing and Connection Follow the manufacturer's instructions to splice fibers or connect pre-terminated connectors. Organize fibers neatly within the box to preven...
