For bends, tees, or risers, pre-measure and cut trays to fit precisely, reducing installation time and errors.

Step 5: Secure and Ground Fasten trays to supports using bolts or clamps, ensuring they are stable and free from movement. Attach grounding straps to maintain electrical safety and comply with regulations.

Step 6: Final Checks Verify tray alignment and level. Ensure tray fill does not exceed 40–50% of capacity to prevent overheating. Check that all cables can be installed without excessive bending or stress.
