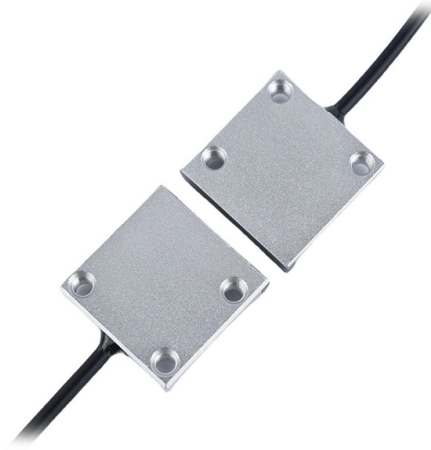


Installation of 24-core fiber optic cable for smart buildings in the Netherlands

Installing 24-core fiber optic cables in smart buildings requires careful planning, adherence to European standards, and structured deployment to ensure high-speed, reliable connectivity for building automation and FTTH networks.

Planning and Design Before installation, conduct a site survey to map all endpoints, intermediate equipment rooms, and potential obstacles such as HVAC ducts or structural beams. Leave 25–40% extra conduit space for future expansion and ensure compliance with DIN EN 50173-1 and ISO/IEC 11801-6 for structured cabling in smart buildings . Determine the fiber type (typically OS2 single-mode for long-distance building backbones) and calculate optical attenuation, keeping it below 0.35 dB/km at 1310 nm for optimal performance .

Cable Selection and Handling For 24-core installations, choose armored or dielectric cables depending on environmental exposure. Use LSZH sheathed cables indoors to reduce fire hazards. During installation, maintain smooth bends, avoid sharp turns, and use figure-8 loops to prevent twisting . Ensure the cable is protected from mechanical stress, sharp edges, and extreme temperatures, and follow the manufacturer's maximum tension and clamping intervals to prevent long-term damage .

Routing and Installation Structured cabling in smart buildings follows a hierarchical design: central building entry → vertical conduits → floor distribution points. In the main distribution room, up to 288 fibers can converge, with modular splice systems and 1U splice boxes accommodating 12 or 24 fibers per cassette . Use media converters to integrate KNX building automation over fiber, ensuring latencies below 1 ms for real-time control . Vertical installations should include frequent clamping to support cable weight and prevent sagging .
