Cutting and Drilling: Cut trays to required lengths and drill holes for mounting as needed, using appropriate tools like saws and drills.

Installing Supports: Attach support brackets or hangers at the marked positions, ensuring they are level and aligned.

Fixing Trays and Fittings: Place trays on supports and secure them with bolts or clamps. Install horizontal and vertical bends, reducers, and end closures as required.

Cable Management: Ensure proper spacing between cables, maintain minimum bend radii, and avoid overloading the tray.

Final Checks: Verify alignment, mechanical stability, and electrical continuity. Ensure accessibility for future maintenance, leaving at least 300 mm cle...
