

Installation of Trapezoidal Cable Trays in Pipe Shafts



AI Overview

Trapezoidal cable trays in pipe shafts should be installed using properly designed supports, aligned and leveled runs, and adherence to safety and code requirements to ensure secure, accessible, and compliant cable management.

Pre-Installation Preparations Before starting, ensure the work area is safe and clear of obstructions. Support and Hanging System The most common support for trapezoidal trays is the trapeze or swing support. Attach slotted GI channels using nuts and washers, ensuring the cross member is level and allows horizontal adjustment for tray clips. Drill holes in the cross member slightly larger than the rod diameter to prevent thread damage and facilitate adjustment.

Tray Installation Position the trapezoidal tray on the supports, ensuring it is aligned, leveled, and securely fastened. Install bends, tees, and other accessories as a complete system before pulling cables. Maintain adequate spacing for cable bending and future maintenance. Use non-combustible covers where the tray passes through walls or partitions to protect cables. Ensure the tray sides are of sufficient height to prevent cable slippage and provide mechanical protection.
