

# Is the patch cord a fiber optic interface

**Connector Types** The interface is defined by the connector type, which ensures precise alignment of the fiber cores for minimal signal loss. Common connector types include:

- LC (Lucent Connector):** Small form factor, push-pull mechanism, widely used in data centers.
- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Square, snap-in connector, common in telecom and PON systems.
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet mount, often used in legacy networks.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications.

- Interconnecting devices:** Linking optical transceivers, switches, and patch panels.
- Data centers and LANs:** Short-distance, high-speed connections within racks or between neighboring equipment.
