This method reduces the risk of mechanical damage and is often used in industrial or high-volume applications.

Chemical Stripping Chemical stripping involves applying solvents to dissolve the polymer coatings. While effective for certain coatings, it requires careful handling of chemicals and thorough cleaning afterward to prevent residue on the fiber, which could affect splicing or connectorization. This method is less common in fieldwork due to safety and environmental concerns.

Automated Stripping Automated systems, such as the AUTOPREP 2™, combine stripping, cleaning, and cleaving in a single process. These machines are designed for high-speed, consistent preparation of fibers, particularly in industrial settings where precision and repeatability are critical. Automated tools minimize operator error and ensure uniform stripping lengths.
