

Laying indoor ceiling fiber optic cables

Use the figure-8 technique when laying loops on the floor to prevent twisting; loops should be large enough (2-4 meters for typical cables) and slightly offset from each other . Maintain the minimum bend radius: typically 10 times the cable diameter after installation, and 20 times during pulling . Avoid kinking, crushing, or sharp bends, especially at corners or when passing through conduits . Securing the Cable Use Velcro straps or specialized fiber clips to attach cables to ceiling joists or cable trays, ensuring they are snug but not tight enough to indent the jacket . If drilling through studs or joists, install plastic bushings or grommets to prevent abrasion . For long runs, monitor the supply reel and pulling process to prevent sudden jumps or excessive tension .
