- Reset the system:** Power cycling the module or pressing a reset button may clear memory or software glitches.

- Visual inspection:** Confirm all lights operate correctly and check for signs of overheating or damage.
- Professional repair:** If diagnostics indicate a module fault, repair or replacement by a qualified technician is recommended. Some services can repair original modules at a reduced cost.
