

Load-bearing installation method for mesh cable trays

Common hardware includes: Hook bolts (GRSM 6) for tray-to-bracket attachment; Overhead hangers (HU 5050, HU 6040) for ceiling installations; U-profiles and head plates for flexible site adjustments. Trays can be connected using welded-on connector lugs or snap-fit systems for rapid assembly.
- 4. Tray Types and Dimensions** Wire mesh trays come in various widths (100–400 mm) and rail heights (35–105 mm) depending on load requirements and cable quantity. Choose trays with sufficient height and wire diameter to support the intended cable load while allowing easy cable insertion and ventilation.
