

# Main distribution box has no ground wire

If your metal electrical box lacks a dedicated ground wire, your primary options are to bond it to an existing metal conduit system (if present and continuous) or to install a Ground-Fault

No ground wire in electrical box (very old building)

If you should 120V box to hot then the box is grounded. Put a ground pigtail with a 10-32 ground screw in the back of the box and tie your ground wire to that.. It's a self grounding device (meaning if the

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
