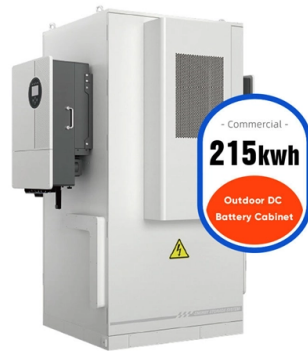

Calculate the current demand and ensure the box can accommodate the main breaker, individual circuit breakers, busbars, and wiring without overcrowding. Each circuit should have a breaker rated for its specific load.

Wiring and Connections Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching the load requirements. Connect phase, neutral, and earth conductors properly, ensuring tight and secure connections to busbars and terminal blocks. Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear labeling of all circuits for safety and future maintenance. All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress.

Protective Devices Include main circuit breakers, individual breakers, fuses, surge protection devices (SPDs), isolators, and disconnect switches to safeguard the system against overloads, short circuits, and voltage spikes. Each circuit should have its own protection, and SPDs are recommended for sensitive electronics.

Grounding and Safety The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and all metallic components must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be reliably connect...
