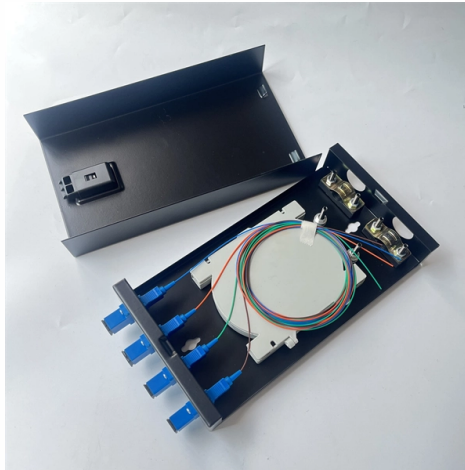


Making a large slope for the cable tray

Calculating Tray Fabrication and V-Cuts For physical installation, you may need to cut V-notches to bend the tray to the required slope. Tools like the Cable Tray Slope & Fabrication Calculator allow you to input the slope angle or measured height and distance, and it outputs the V-cut half-width, full width, marking intervals, and hanger spacing. This ensures precise bending and alignment on-site. Hanger spacing should follow field practice guidelines, accounting for tray width, slope angle, and installation environment. Installation Considerations Hanger Spacing: Proper support is critical. Spacing depends on tray type, width, slope, and cable load. Standard guidelines ensure the tray remains stable and prevents sagging. Tray Type: Ladder trays are ideal for large power cables due to ventilation and support, while ventilated troughs are better for smaller control cables. Offsets and Bends: If the tray must navigate obstacles, calculate offsets using trigonometry or offset calculators to maintain a smooth slope and continuous cable path. Safety and Compliance: Ensure bonding and grounding requirements are met, and avoid slopes that exceed recommended angles (typically under 45°) to prevent installation hazards. Practical Tips Measure the total vertical rise and horizontal run before cutting or bending the tray. Use templates or...
