Cross-Border Renewable Energy Trading: The Energy Exchange Malaysia (ENEGEM) platform facilitates cross-border sales of green electricity to neighboring countries like Singapore and Thailand. The pilot phase includes a 100MW auction for renewable energy sales to Singapore, allowing licensed renewable energy producers to participate in a bidding process. This initiative demonstrates the potential for a regional energy internet where electricity flows seamlessly across borders. 3. Corporate Green Power Integration: Projects under Malaysia's Corporate Green Power Programme (CGPP), such as the 29.99MW solar project supplying Google, showcase real-time, hour-by-hour clean electricity consumption.
