IPEC Technical Requirements for Intelligent Maintenance introduce AI-based monitoring and predictive maintenance for optical networks. This approach specifies functional requirements, interface standards, and reference architectures to enable proactive detection of faults, optimize maintenance schedules, and reduce operational expenditures (OPEX) over the medium term.

Medium-Term Maintenance Practices

Scheduled Inspections: Regular visual and instrument-based inspections of cable routes, joints, and terminations to detect physical damage, moisture ingress, or mechanical stress.

Preventive Maintenance: Cleaning connectors, checking splices, and ensuring proper tension and support for aerial cables to prevent degradation.

Monitoring and Diagnostics: Using optical time-domain reflectometers (OTDRs) and AI-based systems to detect signal loss, attenua...
