Mounting the Enclosure: Select a rigid, secure location capable of supporting the box and internal components. Fasten the enclosure using appropriate bolts and ensure alignment with conduit or cable systems .

Installing Internal Components: Place electrical components according to design specifications, maintaining proper electrical clearance and creepage distances. Use galvanized fasteners and neatly bundle wiring with nylon tape .

Door Installation: Attach the door body to the flange plate using bolts. If a pressing arm is used, connect it between the fixed ear seat and the door to provide auxiliary fixation .

Cable Entry: Use approved conduit sealing fittings or packing glands for all cable entries to maintain explosion-...
