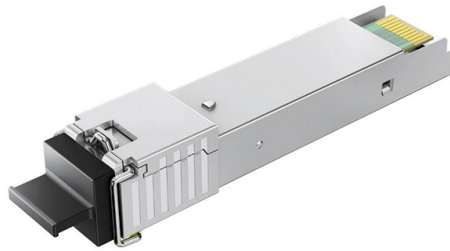

Monaco PON SFP modules are compact, hot-pluggable transceivers designed for high-speed fiber-optic broadband in point-to-multipoint networks, supporting GPON and similar PON architectures.

Overview PON SFP modules are specialized Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) transceivers used in Passive Optical Networks (PONs), such as GPON (Gigabit PON), to deliver high-speed fiber broadband to multiple endpoints over a shared fiber infrastructure. Unlike standard SFPs, which are typically used for point-to-point connections, PON SFPs operate in point-to-multipoint topologies, connecting a single Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs) via passive splitters.

Key Features

- Form Factor:** Standard SFP size, hot-pluggable, compatible with most OLTs and switches that support PON SFPs.
- Connector Type:** Usually SC/APC with simplex fiber for optical connections.
- Wavelengths:** Downstream typically at 1490 nm (OLT→ONU) and upstream at 1310 nm (ONU→OLT).
- Split Ratios:** Supports 1:32, 1:64, or up to 1:128, enabling multiple users to share a single fiber line efficiently.
- Optical Classes:** Classified by power levels (e.g., B+, C+, C++) to match network loss budgets.
- Applications:** Ideal for FTTH, FTTB, and FTTx deployments, municipal broadband, and last-mile optical networks.
- Advantages**
 - Cost Efficiency:** Reduces fiber and active equipment requirements by sharing a single fiber among multiple users.
 - Scalability:** Easily supports network expansion by adding ONUs without major infrastructure changes.
 - Compatibility:** Works with standard SFP slots, allowing integration with existing network hardware.
