

Multimode Fiber Link Module



AI Overview

A multimode fiber link module is a compact optical transceiver that transmits and receives data over multimode fiber for short-distance, high-speed network connections.

Overview A multimode fiber (MMF) SFP module is a small form-factor pluggable transceiver designed to convert electrical signals from network devices into optical signals for transmission over multimode fiber, and vice versa at the receiving end. These modules are hot-swappable, allowing easy installation or replacement without powering down network equipment. They are widely used in data centers, enterprise LANs, and short-range high-density network environments where cost efficiency and performance over short distances are critical.

- Fiber Type:** Multimode fiber with a larger core (50 or 62.5 microns) that supports multiple light paths simultaneously.
- Wavelength:** Typically operates at 850 nm, optimized for short-reach applications.
- Distance:** Supports transmission distances up to 220 meters on 62.5µm fiber and 550 meters on 50µm fiber under optimal conditions.
- Connector Type:** Usually uses duplex LC connectors, requiring two fibers for full-duplex communication.
- Speed:** Commonly supports Gigabit Ethernet (1G), with some modules supporting higher speeds depending on the standard.
- Light Source:** Uses LEDs or VCSELs for efficient short-distance transmission.

Advantages

- Cost-effective:** Lower-cost cables and transceivers compared to single-mode solutions.
- Ease of integration:** Compatible with a wide range of network equipment and simple to deploy.
- High-density support:** Ideal for environments with multiple short links, such as server racks and data centers.
- Hot-swappable:** Minimizes downtime during maintenance or upgrades.

Deployment Considerations

- Distance limitations:** MMF SFP modules are not suitable for long-distance links; single-mode modules are preferred for kilometers-long connections.
- Fiber matching:** Both ends of the link must use compatible multimode SFP modules and fiber types to avoid signal degradation.
