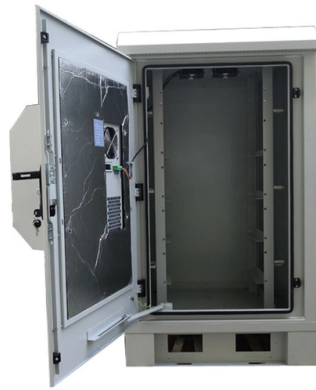

Third-party modules offer significant cost savings, often 60-70% of OEM prices for 400G and 800G transceivers, while maintaining reliability for most enterprise and data center applications.
