

National Standard Galvanized Cable Trays and Steel Cable Trays

The primary national standards for galvanized steel cable trays in North America are NEMA VE 1-2017 and CSA C22.2 No. 126.1-17, which specify manufacturing, galvanization, load ratings, and installation requirements.

Overview of Standards

NEMA VE 1-2017 is the U.S. standard published by the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) and harmonized with the Canadian CSA C22.2 No. 126.1-17 standard. It covers metal cable tray systems, including ladder, ventilated trough, solid bottom, and wire mesh trays, along with associated fittings. The standard specifies material requirements, load/span classifications, and manufacturing tolerances for steel cable trays, including galvanized finishes, ensuring compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC).

CSA C22.2 No. 126.1-17 is the Canadian counterpart, harmonized with NEMA VE 1, providing identical technical content for conformity assessment in Canada. It ensures that galvanized steel cable trays meet Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) Part 1 requirements, including safety, structural integrity, and corrosion protection.

Galvanization and Corrosion Protection

Galvanized steel cable trays are protected against corrosion through hot-dip galvanization or electro-galvanization. Hot-dip galvanization involves immersing steel in molten zinc, forming a zinc coating that provides sacrificial protection, while electro-galvanization deposits a thinner zinc layer via electrolysis. The thickness of the zinc coating directly affects corrosion resistance, and standards specify minimum coating thicknesses for different environmental conditions.

The protective zinc layer naturally oxidizes to form zinc carbonate, creating a durable patina that shields the steel from further corrosion. This ensures long-term durability in indoor, outdoor, and industrial environments.
