- 3. Wiring Practices:** Proper wiring includes secure grounding, correct wire gauge, neat cable management, and double insulation for live parts in metallic enclosures. Overcurrent protection must match the system load, and large feeders require adequate support to prevent thermal hotspots.
- 4. Environmental Considerations:** Panels should be installed in dry, ventilated areas free from water, dust, or corrosive conditions. Outdoor switchgear must meet IP4X, IP5X, or IP6X protection ratings.
- 5. Labeling and Documentation:** All circuits must be clearly labeled to facilitate maintenance and emergency response. Installation details should be recorded for future inspections, and distribution boxes should not be used for storage of documents or flammable materials.
- 6. Compliance with Standards:** Installations must follow NEC (US), IEC 60364/61439 (EU), or BS 7671:2018+A2:2022 (UK). These stan...
