Even if link lights are on, dumb switches may not forward traffic correctly if there is a mismatch in SFP modules or configuration. Consider temporarily connecting devices directly to the router to isolate the problem. Environmental and Hardware Considerations Check for power issues, tripped breakers, or GFCI outlets if the fiber terminal is outdoors.
