- QSFP (Quad Small Form-factor Pluggable):** Supports 40 Gbps or 100 Gbps using four channels, ideal for high-performance computing.
- CFP (C Form-factor Pluggable):** Designed for very high-speed long-distance transmissions.

Optical Port Modules

Optical port modules are the physical interfaces on network devices that connect optical modules to fiber optic cables. Common types include duplex LC, simplex LC, and MTP/MPO connectors. These ports are designed to handle high-speed data transmission over multimode or single-mode fiber, with transmission rates ranging from 2 Mbps to 100 Gbps.
